



Emergency Medicine Core Competences



Emergency Medicine Core Competences is an intensive, 3-day, scenario-based course designed for European EM residents. The course focuses on:

- the initial management of critically ill patients from all age groups
- differential diagnosis and decision-making
- EKG and acid-base interpretation
- neurological evaluation
- basic and advanced airway procedures, intraosseous needle and chest tube insertion, delivery and newborn resuscitation, immobilization of the spine, femur and pelvis
- leadership and communication, including during a major incident

All participants receive a course manual and a pocket-sized checklist compendium covering:

- the initial management of > 30 critical syndromes (e.g. anaphylaxis, pulmonary edema, massive pulmonary embolism, status epilepticus, diabetic ketoacidosis, STEMI)
- the evaluation of patients presenting with one of 20 chief complaints (e.g. abdominal pain, vision disturbance, suspected poisoning)
