

## **Prehospital Section Meeting – Athens, Megaron Center, 26<sup>th</sup> September 12:30 – 14:00**

1. Summary of the activities of the Section since last meeting in Vienna (see presentation attached):

2. Invitation for co-operation with YEMD section – in Athens one pre-hospital session within YEMD track, to discuss mutual involvement for Glasgow.
3. Pros and cons of exchange programmes and visits in EMS in Europe – the question of funding, insurance. Discussion about possibilities. Who could organize and who could participate – should universities be involved?
4. Educational curriculum revision was prepared by small working group, national representatives will be asked for implementation in the next year. PH section members should prepare the revision of PH part of curriculum – especially dispatch is completely missing.
5. Proposal to work on definition of quality indicators for prehospital systems:
  - a. Outcomes? – data from hospitals needed
  - b. Resources?
  - c. Performance?
  - d. Education?
6. Proposal to start work on European textbook on Prehospital care. Systems, indicators mentioned above, dispatch, clinical guidelines for time sensitive emergencies:
  - a. Stroke
  - b. Acute Myocardial Infarction
  - c. Chest Pain
  - d. Major trauma
