Candidate criteria:

EM young professionals

(trainees under the age of 35 or within the first 5 years after completion of their training)

Other specialities in the ED are also eligible with proof of ED activity.

1. EUSEM members must provide membership number.
2. Non-EUSEM members must provide proof of YEMD eligibility (professional status - under training or certificate of completion of training, not older than 5 years) and proof of working in an ED, if trained in a field other specialty than EM.
