EUSEM's 3rd Certification Course is a comprehensive programme that equips Emergency Medicine professionals with the necessary knowledge and skills to manage acute respiratory failure using non-invasive respiratory support effectively. - Understand the underlying pathophysiology of acute respiratory failure and examine the effects of non-invasive respiratory support in patients and other causes of acute respiratory failure.
- Understand the indications and contraindications of the various methods.
- Apply problem-solving skills to troubleshoot ventilator issues effectively.
- Understand pros and cons of Non-Invasive respiratory support in patients.
