

Young Emergency Medicine Doctor applying for "YEMD Fellowship Programme"

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- **EUSEM YEMD member** (trainee or young specialist) **under 35 years** working as emergency medicine doctor in Europe

YEMD FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME OUTLINE

- Different categories of "YEMD Fellowship Programme" are proposed: **(1) clinical fellowship, (2) clinical research work, (3) non-clinical research work, and (4) non-clinical fellowship**
- The applicant can enroll either **short term** (1 - 2 weeks), **long term** (2 - 6 months) or to **work exchange** (paid / unpaid) to **ONLY ONE "YEMD Fellowship Programme"** within recognized EUSEM YEMD hosting center
- Each hosting center will determine **the frequency of candidate application intake** (once annually / twice annually / rolling)
- The candidate applying to "YEMD Fellowship Programme" associated with work exchange has to provide license for practicing clinical work in accordance to local policy of the dedicated hosting center

FUNDING

- Financial support will depend on capacity and local policy of each EUSEM YEMD hosting center

HOW TO CHOOSE HOSTING CENTRE

- Each candidate is advocated to select **three proposed hosting centers** in ranking order
- If none of the preferred centers are available, the candidate will be offered to choose "YEMD Fellowship Programme" within the remaining centres withing EUSEM YEMD network
- "YEMD Fellowship Programme" is available in following hosting centers:
 - 1) Antwerp University Hospital (Adult A&E) in **Antwerp, Belgium**
 - 2) Antwerp University Hospital (Paediatric A&E) in **Antwerp, Belgium**
 - 3) University Hospital Leuven in **Leuven, Belgium**
 - 4) EMS of Central Bohemia Region in **Kladno, Czech Republic**
 - 5) Motol University Hospital in **Prague, Czech Republic**
 - 6) St. Olav University Hospital in **Trondheim, Norway**
 - 7) Inselspital Bern University Hospital in **Bern, Switzerland**
 - 8) Hacettepe University Hospital in **Ankara, Turkey**
 - 9) Akdeniz University Hospital in **Antalya, Turkey**
 - 10) Ege University in **Izmir, Turkey**
 - 11) University Hospital Plymouth NHS Trust in **Plymouth, UK**
 - 12) Ysbyty Gwynedd, Betsi Cadwalad in **Wales, UK**

HOW TO APPLY FOR YEMD FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

- Criteria and scoring system have been established to allow EUSEM YEMD to identify the best and most promising candidates for “YEMD Fellowship Programme”
- Compulsory documents candidate has to provide while applying for “YEMD Fellowship Programme”:
 - ✓ Curriculum vitae (max. 4 pages)
 - ✓ Motivation letter (max. 1 page)
 - ✓ Contact information from 2 references (direct supervisors during EM specialty training)
 - ✓ Letter of recommendation (from one of the references)
 - ✓ Certificate of good standing (not more than 6 months old)
 - ✓ Medical registration number
- Optional documents the candidate may submit while applying for “YEMD Fellowship Programme”:
 - ✓ Successful completion of board exam (EBEEM Part A, EBEEM Part B, FRCEM)
 - ✓ Miscellaneous short courses completed (ALS / ACLS, APLS / PALS / EPLS, ATLS / ETC)
 - ✓ Official certificate of language proficiency (for example IELTS or TOEFL)
 - ✓ Scientific publications in the field of emergency medicine (author or co-author in indexed journals)
 - ✓ Proof of active participation, such as lectures delivery or poster presentations, during national or international emergency medicine conferences

QUALITY CONTROL

- After completion of the “YEMD Fellowship Programme” candidate has to submit completed Feedback Form (Annex D), with regards to overall experience and quality of the “YEMD Fellowship Programme”
